- With over 1.1 million head of beef cattle, Florida is the third largest beef-producing state east of the Mississippi River and tenth in the nation in beef cattle numbers.
- Florida ranches of 1,000 or more head comprise 44 percent of the Florida beef cattle market.
- Florida's vast cattle ranching and agribusiness operations make it primarily a commercial cow/calf producing state, with feeder calves shipped to stocker operations and feedlots located in other states.
